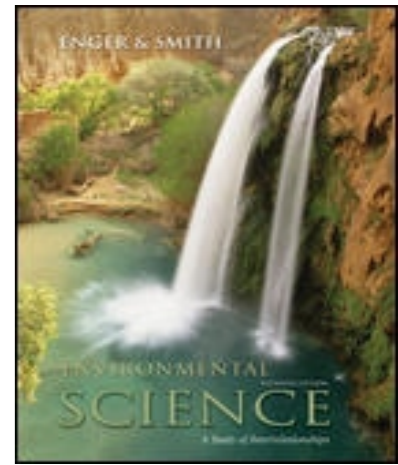


A course of "STREAM ECOLOGY"
