





- mission: ***Support investigator-driven frontier research across all fields, on the basis of scientific excellence***
- special status: run by scientists for scientists
- excellence of **proposed research & the Principal Investigator (PI)**
- **bottom-up principle:** any research field, no predetermined priorities 
- research idea
 - **high-risk, high-gain:** potential of significant breakthrough
 - **not continuation** of previous work (but preliminary results welcome)
- host institution in a Horizon country, PI of any nationality
- budget: personal costs of PI & team, equipment, consumables, dissemination, travel..., overheads

ERC Starting Grants

- up to € 1.5 (+1) million for 5 years
- PI:
 - **2–7 years** after PhD
 - potential for **independence**

Deadline
each year mid-October

ERC Consolidator Grants

- up to € 2 (+1) million for 5 years
- PI:
 - **7–12 years** after PhD
 - experience as leader of a (small) **research team**

Deadline
each year early February

ERC Advanced Grants

- up to € 2.5 (+1) million for 5 years
- PI: **established leader** in the field

Deadline
each year late May

next deadline
23 May 2023

ERC Synergy Grants

- up to **€ 10 (+4) million** for 6 years
- 2–4 PIs, each competitive for Starting/Consolidator/Advanced
 - different countries (1 PI can work outside Europe) or same corridor
 - different fields
- potential for breakthroughs **impossible** if each PI worked **alone**

Deadline
each year mid-November

ERC Proof of Concept Grants

- only for ERC grantees (Starting/Consolidator/Advanced/Synergy)
- verify **innovation potential** of a result of the ERC project

Deadline
3-times a year



ERC Starting Grants

- up to € 1.5 (+1) million for 5 years
- 2–7 years after PhD

ERC Consolidator Grants

- up to € 2 (+1) million for 5 years
- 7–12 years after PhD

ERC Advanced Grants

- up to € 2.5 (+1) million for 5 years
- established leader in the field

ERC Synergy Grants

- up to € 10 (+4) million for 6 years
- 2–4 PIs, each competitive for Starting/Consolidator/Advanced

For what & whom?

- (potential) research team leaders
- exceptional results for their career stage
 - international experience and/or name
 - start/consolidate own research team
 - embark on a new topic
 - long-term funding
 - flexibility & independence



Support for applicants & internal rules

- **system of support**
 - Faculty level – detailed info, individual consultations, comment proposals...
 - National Contact Point – workshops...
- start more than **1 year before deadline**
- University rules (Rector's Directive No. 37/2020)
complete draft sent to rectorate **1 month before deadline**

ERC CZ

- programme by the Czech Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (MŠMT)
- supports ERC proposals – well evaluated but not funded by ERC
 - **“A” but not funded:** whole 5 years funded by ERC CZ
 - (?) **“B” in Step 2:** 2 years funded by ERC CZ
- PI must re-apply for ERC in 2 years

*Wait for the experience
of an ERC CZ grantee.*

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

- goal: “**nurture**” researchers by **international mobility**
- **bottom-up principle:** any research field
research “in service of” participant’s career prospects
- **mobility rule:** supported researchers must **go abroad** to work on MSCA project
(usually: in last 3 years max. 1 year in country where they work on project)
- beneficial & prestigious also for **host institutions & supervisors**
- **inter-sectoral mobility**
“academic sector” – universities & research institutes
“non-academic sector” – anything else
(enterprises, hospitals, museums, national parks, NGOs, public authorities...)
- **funding by unit costs**
fixed amount per person-month spent on project

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

Postdoctoral Fellowships (MSCA-PF)

- individual postdoctoral project with international mobility
- **fellow:** PhD holder, up to 8 years full-time in research after PhD
- European Fellowship
 - **2 years**
 - host institution (beneficiary): Horizon country
 - **fellow:** mobility rule (in country of host institution), any nationality
- Global Fellowship
 - **2 years in non-Horizon country + 1 year reintegration** in Horizon country (beneficiary)
 - **fellow:** nationality or long-term resident of Horizon country
 - mobility rule (in country of outgoing phase)
- prepare application in **close cooperation** with **host institution(s) & supervisor(s)**
- **unit costs:** personnel costs of fellow
 - research, training, networking (postdoctoral research project)
 - management & overheads

next deadline
13 Sep 2023

MSCA-PF: detailed introduction

For what & whom?

- (future) postdocs:** prestigious grant to do research abroad, or to return from abroad
research team leaders: get a postdoc (with funding) from abroad

- University rule (Rector's Directive No. 21/2021): when Charles University is beneficiary by **1 August** notify rectorate, **2 weeks** before deadline send full draft

Funding of unsuccessful proposals

• ERA Fellowships (Horizon Europe, part Widening)

- Host Institution in “Widening country” (e.g. Czechia)
- best European Fellowships under funding cut-off
- automatic re-submission, same rules

• (probably) Programme Johannes Amos Comenius

- Host Institution (or reintegration institution) in Czechia
- both European & Global Fellowships
- at least 70 % in evaluation
- slightly stricter rules



Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

Doctoral Networks (MSCA-DN)

- international network of research teams
 - work on a joint research topic & **train doctoral students**
- consortium typically**
 - ca. 7 beneficiaries (1–2 doctoral students each)
 - + some associated partners – **non-academic sector** (host secondments)
- beneficiaries:** institutions in Horizon countries
- doctoral students:** not PhD holders (when recruited)
 - mobility rule (in country of recruitment), any nationality
- project duration **4 years**, doctoral students employed for **3 years**
- unit costs:** personnel costs of doctoral students
 - research, training, networking (doctoral research projects, summer schools)
 - management & overheads

Staff Exchanges (MSCA-SE)

- international network of research teams – work on a joint research topic & **exchange staff** (doctoral students, researchers, research support staff) by **secondments**
- international secondments**
 - Horizon country vs. non-Horizon country** or **inter-sectoral** (academic vs. non-academic sector), up to 30% can be just inter-disciplinary
 - 1–12 months** per staff member
- recommended consortium:** ca. 6–10 entities
- max. budget: 360 person-months
- project duration **4 years**
- unit costs:** travel expenses (not personnel costs)
 - research, training, networking (research during secondments, meetings)
 - management & overheads

- applicants for positions (fellows): mobility rule (in country of employment)
conditions of particular programme (e.g. research field)

 - defined by Work Programme: currently 2023–**2024** (or 2023)
 - **scope, expected outputs**, type of project, deadline
 - funded ca. 1–5 projects per topic

- applied research
- funding rate 100%

Innovation action (IA)

- bring a promising concept closer to market
- funding rate 70% (100% non-profit entities)

Coordination and support action (CSA)

- “not research”
 - e.g. map existing knowledge, build a platform
 - funding rate 100%

- **budget**: personnel costs, travel, dissemination, overheads...

RIA, IA also: research consumables, equipment(?)

practice

- ca. 8–25 partners
- **multidisciplinary**
- complementarity
 - researchers
 - **users of results**: industry, hospitals, farmers...
- topic requirements:
 - small enterprises,
 - non-European partners...





- infrastructure = equipment, knowledge-based resources, IT tools... made available to **research community**
e.g.: geothermal borehole, herbarium, online database...
- projects should **improve services** offered
- **who?**
researchers involved in **running a research infrastructure**



 - support research in a certain area
 - additional money from Horizon Europe
- **calls**
 - ca. **once a year** (slightly different topic each time)
 - proposals by international consortia
 - researchers can participate **only if their country is involved** (& gives money)
 - international evaluation
 - successful proposal – each partner funded by their national funding body
- partnership (& calls) often **continue** after Horizon (Framework Programme) support has ended



to host institution in widening country (single applicant)
 - known at proposal stage
 - **establishes a research group**
 - attracts further funding
- improve research management practices
(e.g. by trainings)
- 5 years, EUR 1.5–2.5 million
- budget: personnel costs ERA Chair + team members, recruitment
travel, dissemination, management...
research costs up to 10%

next deadline **7 Mar 2024**
