Basic information



Dear students, welcome to Charles University, Faculty of Science!

This guidebook was created to help you to organize your stay in the Czech Republic. Besides maps and plans of the faculty buildings, you can find here many useful web links to detailed important information. We hope this brochure makes your start in Prague smooth and you will enjoy your stay from the very beginning!

Before your arrival

Academic year

The academic year at CU is divided into two semesters. Each semester starts with a lecture period (4.5 months) and ends with an exam period (one month). July and August are holidays (www.cuni.cz/UKEN-26.html).

Study plan

Courses are given in the form of lectures, exercises, seminars etc. There are also field courses or excursions mostly at the end of semester. They are primarily taught in Czech, but there is a wide range of courses guaranteed for foreign students in English. The list of these courses is here: www.natur.cuni.cz/eng/study/erasmus/courses/

It is also possible to study courses outside the list in English, but only with the teacher's approval (for more details see the link above). The complete list of all courses taught at the Faculty of Science can be found here: Student Information System (SIS) is.cuni.cz/studium/eng.

Note that marks are given only for courses finishing with an exam - Examination Ex or C+Ex in the detail of the course! Other subjects can only be evaluated with credit points!

How to apply

The Erasmus applications are submitted via online system here: www.cuni.cz/UKEN-362.html. It includes the request for dormitory accommodation too. A majority of Erasmus and other international students stay at Hostivař dormitory or at Hvězda dormitory (kam.cuni.cz/KAMEN-56.html). After a successful submission, you will be emailed with Letter of Acceptance, confirmed Learning Agreement, information brochure as well as other details concerning your stay in Prague.

Erasmus students also receive an email from the Faculty of Science Erasmus Office (www.natur.cuni.cz/eng/study/erasmus) concerning Orientation Days and Buddy Programme, which is very important for a smooth start at the faculty.

After your arrival in Prague

First you need to check in at your dormitory. The next step is to visit Erasmus Office of the Faculty of Science (www.natur.cuni.cz/eng/study/erasmus). The address is: Na Slupi 16. The office is located in a building on the right behind the entrance to Botanical Garden (nr. 6 on the map on page 12), on the 2nd floor. Check the office hours here: www.natur.cuni.cz/eng/study/erasmus/contacts.

Non-Erasmus student are invited to enrol in the Erasmus Office too.

Erasmus students should attend the Orientation Days when the registration will be completed. Students will be given student coupons which are necessary for the validation of the Student Card. With the assistance of the office staff, admission for courses through the Student Information System – SIS (is.cuni.cz/studium/eng) will be arranged. Students do not enrol to courses by themselves!

Other than Erasmus international students can attend the Orientation Days too, but they should be aware of the fact that it will be very crowded.

The faculty coupon is necessary for getting the student ID card in one of the three university issue centres (www.cuni.cz/UK-2919.html). ID card may be issued with or without ISIC licence. Together with the ID card, students also obtain login and password for faculty online applications (SIS-Student Information System, libraries, canteens etc.) and internet access.

There is WiFi EDUROAM internet connection available in most of Charles University buildings as well as dormitories and several other institutions in Prague (www.natur.cuni.cz/eng/centre-ofinformation-technologies/wifi).

The ID card also permits holders to get discounted public transport pass.

During your studies

If you need to change your study plan, please come to the Erasmus Office, do not enrol to courses by yourself.

Courses taught at CU can finish with an oral exam or a test and students receive credits and a mark (Examination Ex or C+Ex in the detail of the course!). Some courses finish only with a presentation, a written essay etc. After passing, students receive only credits (Examination C in the detail of the course!)

Students register for examination via SIS, where teachers announce exam date including time, place and other details. After completion of a course, teachers enter results in SIS.

If you need, the Erasmus Office provides e.g. confirmation of your arrival or other study documents even for Non-Erasmus international students.

Information such as right/left/back in the Building – location column is accurate when you are standing on the correct floor after exiting the stairs; if there are multiple stairs in the building, then this means the main stairs after entering the building through the main entrance.


