Historical building: "Carolinum" originally a patrician palace

after reconstruction in 1383-1386 residence of the Charles University

- founded in 1348 by the King Charles IV. first university to the north from the Alps and to the east from Paris faculty of liberal arts, medicine, law and theology

 When working in the laboratory, the student must be acquainted with the potential dangers presented by the chemicals and equipment used. In this context, the student is reminded of the need to use protective equipment that is prescribed for the specific laboratory Without these aids, the student shall not be allowed into the laboratory

To follow the instructions and provisions when working with chemical substances in the building (flammable and non-

flammable), to use the designated packaging, designated areas and designated furniture. In particular, students are required

to make sure that the chemical is not confused with food, either by using the wrong packaging or by placing it incorrectly. Students are also obliged to store them so that they cannot be (even due to ignorance) the cause of damage to health.
