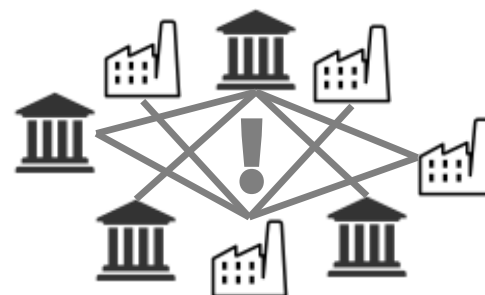

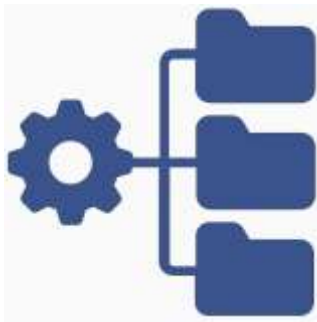
What is Horizon Europe



- European Union's 9th **Framework Programme for Research and Innovation 2021-2027**
 - budget ca. € 95.5 billion (whole duration)
 - centrally managed programme – competition on European level
 - includes e.g.:
 - European Research Council – **ERC grants excellent individual researchers & their ideas 5 year projects, up to € 1.5 – 3.5 million**
 - Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions – e.g. **MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 1-2 year postdoctoral stay, international mobility**
 - projects on pre-defined research topics run by **international consortial** Research and Innovation Actions, Innovation Actions
 - formal adoption ongoing
 - to be finished ca. in April
 - Model Grant Agreement – draft
 - Online Manual – by May (?)
- some educated guesswork in this presentation*

Who & when?



*Beneficiaries must manage the **digital research data generated in the action** ('data') responsibly, in line with the FAIR principles*

Annex 5, Article 17

- “data generated in the action”
 - data **underlying** any output you report as a result of the project
 - scientific papers
 - reports, recommendation for public authorities...
 - any “other data”
- **responsible data management**
 - establish a DMP – and update it regularly
 - deposit data in a trusted repository
 - make data available (if possible) *“as open as possible, as closed as necessary”*
- **costs** related to data management eligible

Establish a DMP

- first DMP – a **deliverable** by **6th month** of the project
- probably: official Horizon Europe DMP template – minimal requirements
– possible to use other (better) templates

- **minimal requirements?** *guess from proposal template*

- **What data?**

- **Findability:** Which repository? Identifiers?

- **Accessibility:** Will you make it available?

**If not made available, why? "as open as possible,
as closed as necessary"**

- **Interoperability:** Standards? Formats?

- **Reusability:** Licenses? Tools needed and their availability?

- **Preservation/curation?** incl. after project's end (repository)

- **Timeline:** When data generated?
put into repository?
made available?

Establish a DMP **and update it regularly**

- DMP should be **a living document** – reflect **changes** that happen
 - research goes differently than planned (new data, different data, data not generated...)
 - new innovation potential
 - other changes (consortium members joining/leaving)
- at least **1 revised DMP** – a deliverable towards the end of project's lifetime

deposit data in a trusted repository

- as soon as possible (planned in DMP)
- call might require a repository federated in the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC)

if possible, make data available
don't have to give access, if:

- against beneficiaries' interests – e.g. plan to **exploit commercially**
- against beneficiaries' other **obligations**
– e.g. security, personal data protection, EU's competitive interests
- **explain in DMP**
- (?) still must be **put in a repository** – just without open access
– will be difficult for European Commission to check

*"as open as possible,
as closed as necessary"*

if possible, make data available

- as soon as possible (planned in DMP)
- open access **via the repository**

- licenses: **data**  



metadata 

- information about **tools needed** to re-use

About Creative Commons licenses

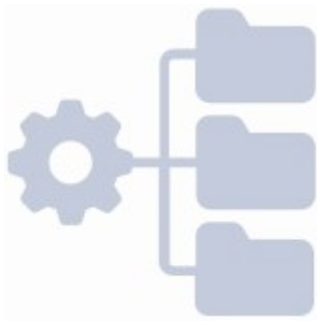

Public emergency

- specified by the call (e.g. medical research)
- request of granting authority – beneficiaries must give access to data
 - via repository  
 - “at fair and reasonable conditions” to relevant actor(s)
- up to **4 years** after the end of the project

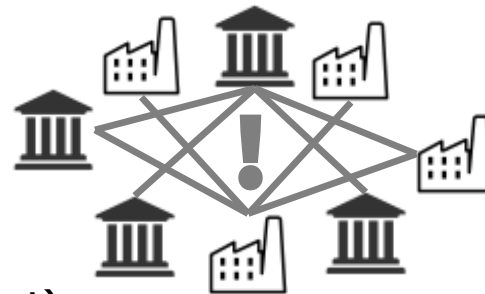

Who & when?



Who?

- DMP & data management for whole project
- partner in a consortium:
follow instructions of coordinator
/ task leader for data management
- coordinator: **your responsibility**
(set a task leader for data management)
- ERC grant, MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship
(mono-beneficiary project, a researcher in charge):
your responsibility



When? **Project implementation** – *see previous slides*

When? **Proposal writing**

- **ERC grant** – not so much
 - proposal just about science
 - **plan costs** (person-time) in the budget
- other proposals: projects run by **consortia, MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship**
 - **some outlook** already in proposal
e.g. consortial project proposal:
1 page on data management
 - **consortium**: plan the **person in charge & budget**
MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship: plan **time** to do it, who will **help** you
 - Gantt chart: plan DMP and its update(s) as deliverables
 - probably will **effect evaluation**
