HOW TO WRITE A COMPETITIVE PROPOSAL FOR INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIPS?

The event will explain the funding philosophy, proposal structure and evaluation procedure of Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) – Individual Fellowships (IF) under the Horizon 2020 programme. It will have a special focus on practical aspects of proposal writing and will be followed by interactive questions and answers sessions. MSCA evaluators and fellows will be present.

A more general part in the morning open to all researchers and project managers will be followed by an interactive applicants' workshop in the afternoon open only to researchers who already have agreed with their future host institution/supervisor on a concrete work plan and are currently preparing a MSCA-IF proposal for the 2015 call. In the afternoon session you will have a unique opportunity to work with a successful MSCA-IF proposal from the field of chemistry and to look at your proposal from evaluators' perspective. Moreover, you will receive feedback about your CV and abstract.

For the applicants' workshop in the afternoon a CV (max. 5 pages) and a short abstract of the proposal (max. 2000 characters) according to the MSCA-IF Guide for Applicants¹ are required to be sent to Ms. Z. Dvorakova (<u>dvorakovaz@tc.cz</u>) till May 18.

The event will be held in English. Translations will not be provided.

A separate registration is required for each of the sessions.
