Note:

The applicant must be an internationally recognized scholar in his/her research area and is expected to teach two 90-minutes courses per week at the advanced undergraduate level. The curriculum of the courses must be proposed by the applicant and is an obligatory part of the application. At least one of the courses should introduce topics related to the recent research of the applicant. Courses are given in English, knowledge of the Czech language is not required.

Candidates will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- recognized scholar from a respected foreign institution
- excellent research (H-index and other scientometrics, originality of scientific results/quality of publications)
- form, extent and focus of the offered subjects/courses
- contribution to the strategic plans of the host institution/section
- attractiveness of the applicant's research/teaching to different departments of the section

**Qualifications:**

Pedagogical and scientific practice in the field, advanced English language skills, successful completion of the professor appointment procedure or successful completion of the habilitation procedure or comparable education from abroad.

**Documentation required from candidates:** cover letter, curriculum vitae, research statement, teaching statement, list of publications and curriculum of the proposed courses.
