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Contents of the Summer School 2011

The summer school »Sustainable Development on the Baltic coast« focuses on interdisciplinary issues from an international and national context. In particular, problem areas in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern's coastal regions will be discussed.

During the summer school 2011 the following points will be dealt with:

- Integrated Coastal Zone Management: strategies and activities
- Sustainable development and tourism: visions and reality?
- Windenergy: challenges and chances
- Aquatic ecology: water protection and water use

For these and other topics, lectures and practical exercises will take place, through discussions, role plays and group work. Also excursions guided by our experts are included.



Target group

The summer school aims towards scientific, engineering and human sciences postgraduates. Participants with a Bachelor degree must have a minimum of 180 credit points.

The summer school is especially aimed towards foreign postgraduates. Very good or good language knowledge is necessary as our teaching will all be conducted in German.

The postgraduates should have an interest in sustainable development and be looking towards a career in a corresponding field.

Application

Applications should be submitted in German with the following documents attached:

- Letter of motivation, stating reasons for participation in the summer school
- CV with a recent photo
- Leaving certificate (certified copy)

The full application must be submitted in paper to the Center for Quality Assurance in Study and Further Education before the 15th of May 2011.

Study structure

The summer school consists of a 14-day course in Rostock, as well as online preparation time before and after the course. In preparation for the summer school the participants must use the online platform to perform research and complete exercises.

Certificate and credit points

All successful participants will receive a certificate from the University of Rostock and a supplement with additional qualification information. These participants will be awarded 10 credit points.

Further information

Dates:

The 14-day summer school takes place from the 29th of August to the 11th of September 2011 in Rostock. In addition to that preparation time before and after the course has to be planned.

Costs:

Participation in the summer school costs 210 Euro, including seminars, lectures, excursions and hostel. The German Academic Exchange Service gives a maximum grant of 325 Euro.
