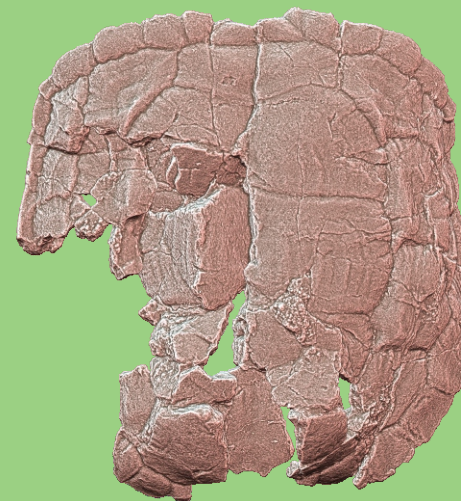
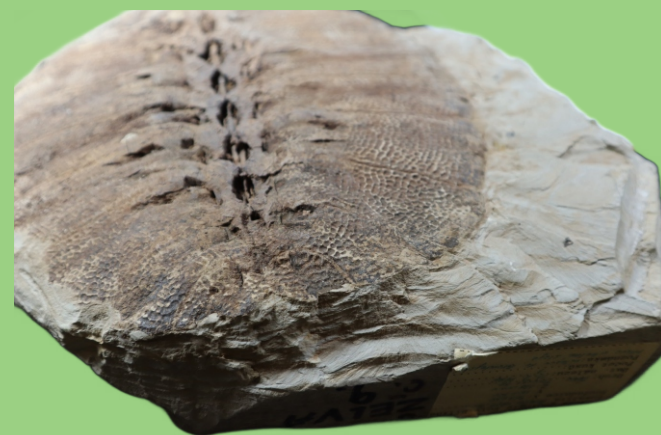

The world of ancient turtles – the place of Central Europe in the context of fossil turtle diversity



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Turtles (Testudinata) appeared in the Late Triassic (~215 mya) and from the very beginning their history is associated with the region of modern-day Central Europe, including Czechia and Poland.

Although in the Holocene the specific diversity of those animals in our part of the continent dwindled, they were much more speciose and diverse in the past. The presentation will summarize the historical records and newly acquired data on turtle finds from the area in question, particularly in the Mesozoic
